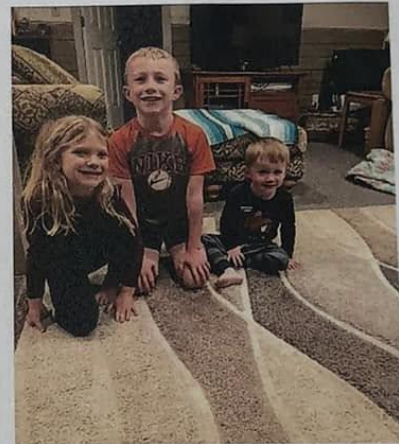
God Identifies

Pork Barbecue

1 Boneless Pork Loin Roast (3-4lbs)

1 ½ tsp seasoned salt

1tsp garlic powder

1 C barbeque sauce

1C cola

8 to 10 sandwich rolls

Cut roast in half, place in a slow cooker.

Sprinkle with seasoned salt and garlic powder. Cover and cook on low for 4 hrs.

or until meat is tender. Remove meat, skim fat from cooking juices. Shred meat with a fork and return to slow cooker.

Combine barbeque sauce and cola and pour over meat. Cover and cook on high 1-2 hours or until sauce is thickened.
